It only shows if we give you the link information. This allows you to re-enroll before we open it to the public. This helps us with our planning for next year, and when you complete the intent to re-enroll form online, your student's name(s) will be added to our open house scholarship drawings. When you attend the Open House on Thursday, March 12th from 5-6:30 p.m., you will have another opportunity to sign up for the scholarship drawings. If you have submitted your enrollment in March your registration fee is also waived.

The Open House will give you an opportunity to speak with President Hoganson, Mr. Isaac and myself, speak with the teachers, tour the classrooms, enroll for the 2020-2021 school year, and learn more information about our B4 School care, Son-Shine Kids After School care, PTF, the FACTS Student Information System, Band & Orchestra info from Mr. Clark, and let us know if you are interested in a Summer Enrichment Day Care program. Also new next year is fulltime Pre-K or halftime A.M. only Pre-K on Mon., Wed., and Fridays. Preschool will remain on Tuesday and Thursday mornings.
