Mrs. Aamot's State of the School Update

How are we doing? This is a time that few, if any of us, have ever experienced. I know as families you are faced with so many challenges and changes, and we appreciate the effort that goes into suddenly changing your lives. I continue to be asked how I am, and how is my staff? We pray together, work hard, and feel the prayers of others for

us. Our Morning Son School Board met Monday night to pray over our school, and affirm the direction we are taking to provide distance learning while keeping in line with our educational goals. We are listening to the needs of our families and staff, and working to be in compliance with the government mandates that continue to be updated as we speak. I offer prayers for the food staff at Kennedy, tasked with feeding an unpredictable number of children at multiple locations daily. We volunteered to be a food distribution site, providing free breakfasts and lunches to our students. A detailed description was emailed to each of you earlier today. We, as a school also plan to continue providing meals for the Salvation Army school program. They were so grateful when we called to assure them we would continue.

And that is the difference! We are a family of people extending the love of Jesus to each other, and to the community the best we can.

I believe our teaching staff is amazing with the dedication they are demonstrating to provide an educational plan for each of your children. It may seem like a daunting task to start schooling from home, but we are here to walk through this with you. But I do believe our teachers are sending home well trained students ready to take on their learning challenge.
